ADDITION FACTS CHART: COLORING DIRECTIONS

Use **PURPLE** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Adding Zero,” when zero is added to any other number.

These facts will be PURPLE: $0+0$, $3+0$, $0+7$, and many more

Use **BLUE** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Counting On,” when adding the small numbers 1 or 2 to any other number. Remember to look at the largest number first whether it’s on the top or the bottom, and then count on 1 or 2.

These facts will be BLUE: $2+1$, $5+2$, $1+9$, $2+8$ and many more

Use **RED** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Doubles,” when the two numbers you are adding are the same.

These facts will be RED: $3+3$, $5+5$ and many more

Use **ORANGE** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Neighbors,” when the two numbers you are adding are neighbors on a numberline.

These facts will be ORANGE: $4+5$, $8+7$, $3+4$ and many more

Use **YELLOW** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Adding 10’s,” when you add 10 to any other number.

These facts will be YELLOW: $10+5$, $6+10$, $10+2$ and many more

Use **GREEN** to color each addition fact that uses the strategy “Adding 9’s,” when you add 9 to any other number.

These facts will be GREEN: $9+5$, $3+9$, $9+2$ and many more

Many of the addition facts are now colored with one or two colors – these are facts you know using a few strategies. The remaining facts that are uncolored are the ones you may need to memorize or perhaps use another strategy to solve.
